Pink Orchids- provides help and support to younger women

Pink Peonies- provides Tamworth patients with a meeting point and help and support.

The charity also provides each patient with a supply of the make up used at the workshop to take away.

Members of the committee continue to promote breast awareness by giving talks and our aims and objectives are featured on our web site and on facebook. We continue to send out regular newsletters to our members letting them know about future events and services. Our current newsletter is also accessible through our web-site

Breast Friends continues to offer, free of charge, ongoing practical support. Health professionals refer patients in need of :-

small grants, home help, door to door laundry service, childcare, gardening, the provision of an electrically operated riser/recliner chair, a wheelchair, a mobility scooter, a rented stair lift, a pamper afternoon or make up workshop. We aim to improve the quality of life for breast cancer patients in any way we can particularly the very seriously ill.

Although receipts from fund raising and donations increased by 4.5% over the previous year our outgoing commitments escalated by a massive 21% culminating in the charity needing to use £16,500 of our reserve funds. This figure represents approx 15% of our reserve capital and highlights the need to escalate our fund raising if we are to continue to offer the ongoing practical support we have given to date. The local community has continued to support our charity but unfortunately costs have increased as more breast cancer patients are in need of our help.

Our main aim in the coming year will be to increase our fund raising efforts and hope that the wonderful support from the local community will continue.
